

**ORDINANCE No. 2011-01**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS  
OF THE BARTLETT FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT,  
COOK AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS,  
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2011  
AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Bartlett Fire Protection District, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, caused to be prepared in tentative form a Budget and Appropriation for the Fiscal Year 2011 commencing January 1, 2011 and ending December 31, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the Secretary of this Board has made the same conveniently available for public inspection for at least (30) days prior to final action thereon; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing was held as to the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, on the 19th day of January, 2011, at 6:50 PM; and

**WHEREAS**, Notice of the time and place of public hearing regarding the Budget and Appropriation was published in a newspaper in a timely manner as required by the Illinois Municipal Budget Law, (50 ILCS 330/1 et. seq.).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Bartlett Fire Protection District, Cook and DuPage Counties, as follows:

**SECTION 1:**

That the fiscal year of this Fire Protection District is hereby fixed and declared to begin on January 1, 2011 and end on December 31, 2011.

**SECTION 2:**

That the following Corporate Budget, containing an estimate of the revenues expected to be received by the Bartlett Fire Protection District during the FY 2011 fiscal year from all sources, an estimate of the expenditures contemplated for such fiscal year, and a statement of the estimated cash expected to be on hand at the end of such year, be and the same is hereby adopted as the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance for this Fire Protection District for said fiscal year; and the following sums of money:

SECTION 7: A copy of this ordinance shall, within thirty (30) days of its passage and approval, be published once in a newspaper published in the District or if no such newspaper is published in the District then this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the District.
